

Course Description

Math 3 progresses from the standards learned in Math I and Math II. In addition to these standards, Math III extends to include algebraic concepts such as: the complex number system, inverse functions, trigonometric functions and the unit circle. Math III also includes the geometric concepts of conics and circles.

Materials Needed

- 3-ring binder (1 inch or larger)
- Scissors and Glue
- Lined paper and Graph paper
- Pencils and erasers
- Graphing calculator (TI-83 model or higher)... This calculator will be used in this class and ALL future math classes.



Expectations

Grading

Letter grades will be assigned using the percentages in the student handbook. Points are earned through tests, quizzes, in-class activities, projects, and homework. Your six weeks grades will be weighted as follows:

20% Class work & Homework 30% Quizzes 50% Tests

Binders

The purpose of the 3-ring binder is to help you stay organized. You should organize it the following way: either with dividers (notes, homework, quizzes), or keep everything in order based on titles and numbers. Organization is VERY important to help you succeed in this course and is crucial to assist you on your homework quizzes.



Notes

We will take notes each class period. I may provide you with guided notes, if I do they will be located in a basket on the shelf in the front of the classroom. It is your responsibility to pick these up before you take your seat. I strongly encourage you to ask for help during class, or after, but you must show me your notes before I will help you. You need to put in the time and effort initially in order to receive my extra time and effort. If you are ABSENT, you must get notes from a friend or use the class website.

Homework & Classwork 20% of grade

Homework will be assigned almost every day. Thus, in order to be successful in this class, you must not let yourself fall behind. You must show all of your work to receive full credit. It is your responsibility to check your homework assignments carefully each period and ask questions about any problems or concepts that you do not understand. Late work is not accepted! Daily assignments will be checked in at the beginning of class for a stamp/signature on your stamp sheet. Do not lose the stamp-sheet, this is the only way to receive credit for completed homework. Class-work will not happen daily, however, class-work encompasses many different things. For example: in class worksheets, group participation, class participation, writing assignments, etc.

Quizzes 30% of grade

Each quiz will be announced or listed. Each unit will have at least one quiz on the material covered. HOMEWORK QUIZZES will occur every Friday. Homework quizzes will consist of problems from any homework assignment from that week as well as problems from the notes, thus you need to show your work on your homework and notes!!!

Tests 50% of grade

Tests will be announced and listed. They will usually take the entire class period and notes or homework will NOT be allowed. No extra time will be given. Calculators may be used on most quizzes and tests. If a student is absent on the day of a quiz or test, they have exactly 3 days from the day they return to come in for a make-up. It is the responsibility of the student to schedule a make-up time with me. Failure to do so without speaking to me could result in a score of 0. If a student is absent on the day of a review for a quiz or test, they are still expected to take the quiz or test when they return. Skipping a quiz or a test will result in a 0!

Charger Academy

Math assistance is available Monday - Thursday after school through Charger Academy. Transportation can be provided. This is an excellent tool to use if you feel yourself falling behind in class. If you wish to attend, simply tell me so I can sign you up for a specific day.

Projects (included in the test portion of grade)

Various projects may be given throughout the course of a semester. Students will be given specific instructions and due dates at the time the project is assigned.
